Parking fees.

The following fees have to be paid for parking on explicitly designated parking areas on the show grounds:

Rules and Regulations for the European Paint Horse Championship 2008:

(1) Entries

- The entry form must be filled out completely and correctly. It has to be sent on time to the address stated above.
- All fees must be transferred completely to the bank account stated above
- A copy of the Certificate of Registration must be included. Weanlings which are shown in the APHA Weanling Halter classes must have a Certificate of Registration, which has to be shown in the show office at the arrival at the latest.
- Every exhibitor has to include a copy of the APHA membership-card. In case of (Novice) Amateur or youth entries, a copy of the (Novice) APHA Amateur card or AJPHA card has to be included. New memberships or renewals can be purchased at the show office.

(2) Rules

The show is judged according to the APHA rule book 2008 and the PHCG-Futurity/Maturity according to the PHCG Futurity and Maturity regulations.

(3) European Champions

European Champions will be awarded in the categories youth, novice amateur, amateur and open.
Only horses which are in European ownership during the EPHC are eligible for the European Champion title.

The results of all five APHA shows count for the European champion title. There are no final runs. In classes with less than 3 participants, no European Champion title is awarded. In classes with more than 5 participants a European Champion (gold medal) and Reserve European Champion (silver medal). In classes with more than 6 participants a bronze medal is awarded additionally. The top ten riders in the EC-class will get ribbons. No ribbons or trophies will be awarded at the five APHA-shows.

The European and Reserve European Champions will be determined by 3 judges' placings, which each horse's lowest and highest placing discarded.

In placed classes, each judge will place up to 11 horses. The numerical scores for placing will be determined using the following scale:

Ties will be broken by a tie-breaker judge. The tie-breaker judge will be announced prior to each class.

(4) European Allaround-Champion

An Allaround Champion will be awarded in youth, amateur and open classes for each show.

The European Allaround-Champion is calculated by adding the points of the 5 APHA shows. In case of a tie for the European Allaround-Champion, the horse (1) competing and placing in most categories, (2) having won the most European Championships, (3) having won the most Reserve European Championships.

(5) German Champion

All German Champions are awarded according to the rules in (3). In order to earn a German Championship, the horse has to be in German ownership during the European Championships.

(6) Drugs and medication

By signing the entry form, each participant or horse owner agrees to the possibility of taking a specimen of blood or urine for testing. The show follows the rules and regulations of the APHA rule book.

In case of discovery of administration of drugs, the participant or horse owner has to pay for all costs. The horse-rider-combination is disqualified from all classes in which it participates or has participated at the show and has to return all prize money and other prizes. The organizing association is able to subject the horse involved, as well as the responsible or involved parties to further penalties.

(7) Vaccination /horse transportation papers / health papers

Each horse must have a valid insurance, has to be free of any epidemic, be originally from a barn free of any epidemic and have an influenza vaccination. The horse transportation and vaccination papers must be brought along and shown at the show office. **Horses from any other country except Germany have to hand in the horse's health papers signed by a licensed veterinarian.**

(8) Clipping

The Paint Horse Club Germany e.V. will examine clipped horses according to the rules which are posted on the PHCG web site or can be ordered at the PHCG office.

All participants who are not a member of the PHCG, can be examined by a licensed veterinarian. Clipping is not allowed according to German laws.

(9) Reimbursements

50% of the entry fee can be reimbursed, if a valid veterinarian certificate is shown. Cattle Charge and Office Charge cannot be reimbursed. Box fees can only be reimbursed, if the box can be sold to another participant.

(10) Insurances and other regulations

The organizing association is able, according to the APHA rule book, to change the show conditions, pre- or postpone the show, or cancel the show (reimbursement of fees) under special circumstances. Furthermore, certain classes will be cancelled (reimbursement of fees), if too few participants have entered up to the deadline for entries. The organizing association is not responsible for lost or late post delivery.

Each horse has to have a valid insurance.

Each horse owner accepts the rules and regulations of the organizing association, the APHA rule book and this show booklet by signing the entry form. All other visitors do so by entering the show grounds.

There is no contract between the organizing association and the horse owners, visitors and participants. Therefore, liability for stolen objects or injuries of persons or horses is excluded. Participants are not „Gehilfen“ (assistant) according to § 278f and § 831 BGB.
